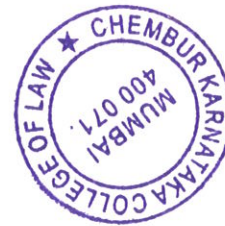

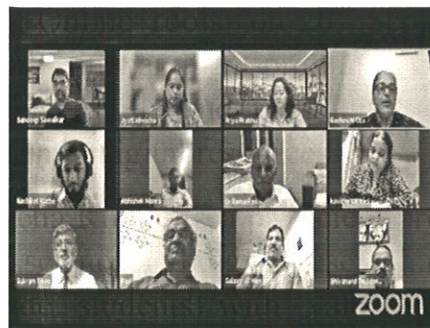
**RESEARCH AND DATA ANALYSIS USING ONLINE TOOLS
